## What is the product?

**Type:** This Product is an investment company qualifying as UCITS Sub-fund in accordance with the UCITS law.

**Term:** This Product has no maturity date. The Sub-fund has been established for an indefinite period of time. The Board of Directors of the Investment Company is entitled to liquidate, merge or reposition the Product at any time unilaterally in case the Product can no longer be managed in the interest of the investors. The amount the investor will receive upon early termination may be less than the amount invested.

**Objectives:** This Sub-fund is actively managed with reference to the MSCI World Infrastructure Net Total Return Index (the "Benchmark") with the exclusive objective of performance comparison or investor communication purposes. The Sub-fund is aiming to a to achieve long-term capital growth and current income by investing predominately (at least 80%) in global infrastructure-related companies. The Sub-fund promotes environmental, social and governance (ESG) characteristics (within the meaning of Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2088) through a combination of different portfolio management techniques. Details are available in the prospectus and the ESG website disclosure of the fund. The Investment Manager will use its discretion to significantly deviate from the weighting of certain components of the benchmark and to significantly invest in companies or sectors not included in the benchmark in order to take advantage of specific investment opportunities. It is thus expected that the performance of the Sub-fund will significantly deviate from the benchmark. The Sub-Fund will invest at least 40% of its net assets, plus the amount of any borrowings for investment purposes, in securities of companies organized or located in at least three non-U.S. countries. Up to 20% of the Sub-fund's net assets may be invested in bank deposits at sight, such as cash. However, in exceptionally unfavourable market conditions it may, on a temporary basis go up to 100%. The Sub-fund is not limited to a certain currency, sector or geographical scope, although investments in emerging markets will not exceed 20% of its net assets. In order to reach its objective, the Sub-fund can use derivative instruments for investment and hedging purposes and efficient portfolio management. In addition, the Sub-fund might also invest in structured products (up to 10%). The Sub-fund uses derivatives to reduce the impact of changes in currency exchange rates on the performance for this Share Class. The investor can buy or sell shares on a daily basis (Luxembourg bank business days). This Share Class makes regular distributions. The Sub-fund shall bear the costs of standard brokerage and bank charges incurred by the Sub-fund through securities transactions in relation to the portfolio.

**Intended Retail Investor:** This Product is intended for retail investors with sufficient knowledge and experience in collective investment schemes and similar products, an ability to bear an average investment loss, and a long-term investment horizon.

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

### (A) Summary Risk Indicator



**The risk indicator assumes you keep the Product for 7 years. The actual risk can vary significantly if you redeem at an early stage and you may get back less.**

The Summary Risk Indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this Product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the Product will lose money because of movements in the markets. We have classified this Product as 4 out of 7, which is a medium risk class and poor market conditions could impact our capacity to pay you. **Be aware of currency risk** if your reference currency differs from the currency of the Product. You may receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies.
